A well-known 19th-century French journalist and writer, Gautier began his career as an artist, which explains the unusual depth of visual detail and color in his writing. If you think that a 150-year-old travelog might be dated, think again. In this latest installment in Interlink's "Lost and Found" series, originally published in French in 1845, Gautier doesn't dilute his strong opinions about his experiences, both positive and negative. Clearly, he doesn't write to satisfy a tourist office but instead to give his own lively reactions to Spain, which at the time was relatively unknown to the rest of the world. The depth of description of the Escorial (Philip II's last palace) would put many contemporary travel writers to shame. And Gautier's account of the perils of carriage travel, country inns, and local cooking show us what modern tourists are missing as they travel across Spain today. Still, this is not merely a primer: experienced travelers to Spain will learn many new details about Spanish history, art, architecture, customs, and folklore. This special time capsule of Spain as seen through the eyes of one gifted writer is highly recommended for European travel as well as literature collections. Olga B.
